If you do find a hoebble rock here's what ~~to~~ you can and can't do:

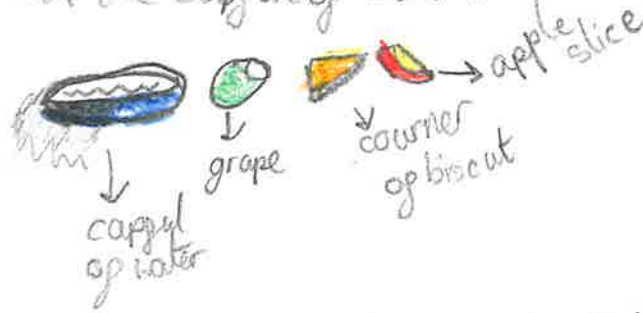
- You can't touch the hoebble rocks

What do Hoebbles eat?

Hoebbles typically like grapes, apples, a corner of a biscuit and a lid full of water. Here I've said a corner of a biscuit because they are quite small for grapes only put one grape in the hoebble bed and one apple slice. You don't need all of these but you need at least something with the capful of water.



Where to put your hoebble bed

You should put your hoebble bed in a quiet space where it can feel safe while resting.

Types of hoebbles

One of them is called the Terranean (Earth hoebble) and these hoebbles look after the Earth, soil and the ground.

Another of them is called an Aerial (Air hoebble) and these hoebbles look after the air, check the tops of trees and help birds to make their nests.
