- *The Firebird was first performed by the <u>Ballets Russes</u> in <u>Paris</u> at the Théâtre National de l'Opéra on <u>25 June</u> <u>1910</u>.
- *The story of the ballet is based on a <u>Russian fairy tale</u>. The music was composed by <u>Igor Stravinsky</u>. It was Stravinsky's first ballet score.
- *His ballet The Rite of Spring caused a riot when it was first performed!
